

Artist Doctors Art & Craft Exhibition

Guidelines for exhibiting

- To be eligible to exhibit you should be a doctor, training to become a
 doctor, or connected to the medical profession in some way. The
 committee reserves the right to make a final decision.
- We limit the number of paintings to 1 3 of an average size. (1metre x 1metre).
- A display of photographs should be no larger than 1-2 average size paintings.
- Exhibits may be sold, but the committee does not get involved. The
 artist can supply contact details which can be given to anyone
 interested in making a purchase.
- Security and Insurance The Organizers will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibitors' goods and exhibitors are reminded that they should take out their own insurance to cover for this.
- Exhibits are required on the morning of the 18th of May by mid-day.
 The committee reserves the right to decline work submitted for
 exhibition if they feel the subject matter is unsuitable. Exhibits must
 be clearly labeled with the exhibitor's name on the back. All relevant
 packaging should also be named so that it can be returned to the right
 person. Artwork should be ready to hang i.e., wire or cord attached to
 the back of the work.
- Exhibits must be collected after the concert on Saturday evening.
